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

Australia & NZ

Construction on Auckland's planned airport light rail line is unlikely to get underway before mid-2020, New Zealand Transport Minister, Phil Twyford, said on Friday (15 June).

He admitted earlier promises of having construction of the NZD 4bn (USD 2.8bn) project begin in 2019 had been ambitious. "There were a couple of reckless things said during the election," he told delegates at the Informa NZ Rail conference.

Still, numerous global and local rail construction companies, investors and advisers are circling the project as it is by far the biggest deal in the NZ market.

They include <u>Transdev</u>, <u>Acciona</u>, Broadspectrum, HRL Morrison, <u>Marubeni</u>, <u>Bouygues</u> and Itochu's I-Environment Investments Pacific and <u>Macquarie Capital</u>.

Industry sources expect the market sounding and business case development to take until the end of the year, when the process for procuring the project may be announced.

Sources close to the project in the NZ Transport Agency (NZTA) said they are just beginning market sounding and work on the business case, however. They are consulting widely overseas, including with the NSW government on lessons learned from the problems the <u>Sydney Light Rail (SLR) project</u> is now facing.

It is understood they are looking at raising the line about 150mm above the road surface, limiting the need to dig up the road and buried utilities which have created problems for the SLR project.

They say the final route has not been decided, although some of it is expected to run down Dominion Road and along old tram routes abandoned in the 1950s.

Some have argued it will not be a very quick way to get from the city to the airport, although light rail usually has its own corridor that separates it from road traffic, unlike a tram. An "indicative" business case by Auckland Transport in 2016 found light rail would be <u>almost as quick as a heavy rail option it considered</u> and around half the cost.

Auckland Mayor, Phil Goff, said on Thursday (14 June) that he expected the project would be a PPP, but Twyford and

government officials stressed they had to properly consider the options.

"The transport agency could borrow over 30 years or we could do it through a PPP," Twyford said.

"We are going to measure twice and cut once," Twyford said. "We want to get the governance, the planning, the financing, route alignment and the planning permissions – do all that work upfront and learn as much as we can."

Environmental impact assessments and planning consent would need to take place after the market soundings and business case development. These would be followed by land acquisitions before a tender could be launched. Under present planning processes this is unlikely to take until early 2020.

Urban development

The government is proposing a new Urban Development Authority (UDA) that may be able to push the process faster. Twyford said staff in the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Urban Development had already formed the "embryo" of the UDA to start planning work while they wait on legislation planned for introduction later this year.

The project is as much an "urban development" project as an airport link the government said. It now favours calling the line the City to Mangere Light Rail, referencing a relatively poor area of Auckland near the airport.

The NZTA will be working with Housing NZ to acquire land along the route to place subsidised housing mixed with new houses at market rates. This would also help the business case as it would add a ready source of passengers.

"Not only can [light rail] deliver high quality rapid transit for people to move around our cities, but it has demonstrated in dozens of cities around the world that it is a magnet for private sector investment and urban renewal and urban transformation," Twyford added. "That's why we favour light rail. The permanence that it has is the very reason it attracts apartment buildings and pedestrian friendly urban spaces," he added.

He acknowledged the difficulty in attracting people and companies with the skills needed and what this might mean for the cost of the project, but said he wanted to build a pipeline of projects that would attract expertise to New Zealand.

Second light rail line

The government has also committed to a second light rail line running from the city to the north west. It says another "rapid transit" line, which Twyford said is likely to be light rail, from the city to the North Shore over a second harbour crossing will be needed by 2030 when the present express bus service will be over capacity.

But questions have been raised about how construction of the light rail projects may disrupt two major events in Auckland in 2021 – the Americas Cup and the APEC meeting.

A confidential report handed to Auckland Council Mayor Phil Goff last year has <u>also emerged in local media</u>. This report said fast tracking the airport rail line to complete before these events would subject it to major risks, including the difficulty of getting contractors and skilled labour already overstretched in other markets such as Australia.

There are also concerns about the level of expertise in government agencies, which have never procured a light rail project.


